This month let's start an ongoing conversation regarding Civility. What is Civility? Actually this has been a very difficult question to answer. It usually has been easier to identify what Civility is not (incivility), and then indicate Civility is the opposite of incivility.

What I propose is that Civility is a fundamental respect for others. Civility can also be thought of as a set of beliefs and behaviors. If one has a fundamental respect for others, it will be natural to practice civil behaviors.

As I think through the ideas of civility, if one can accept the concept that Civility starts with a fundamental respect for others, then (at least to me), civility starts with yourself. I need to work on my own ability to show respect for others and be less concerned about how other people act.
