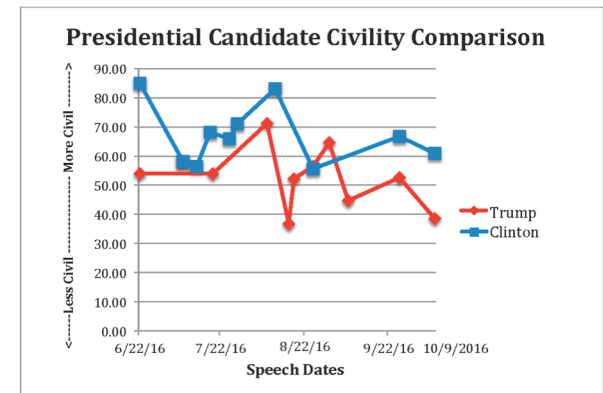
By showing society what it means to meet on the level, subdue our passions, and act upon the square, we can make a difference. Now is the time, and we are the ones to do it.
